The testing cycle for the DeKalb County Sheriff's Office will begin on **April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008 at 8:00 a.m.** at the **Northern Illinois University Recreation Center**. The Center is located at the corner of Annie Glidden Road and Stadium Drive, DeKalb, Illinois.

Part I. of the testing that day is the Peace Officer Wellness Evaluation Report (P.O.W.E.R.). This is a physical test, a copy can be obtained upon request. Those who successfully pass the P.O.W.E.R. test will, after an ample break be administered Part II. of the testing cycle which is the written test. This test will be in a classroom at the same location as the P.O.W.E.R. test. During the break mentioned above showers will be available, please bring your own towel.

Applicants, who successfully pass the written test, will be scheduled for Part III of the testing cycle, oral interviews conducted by the Merit Commission. Dates to be announced.

All candidates must be available for all phases of the testing cycle, at the time designated. There are no make-up times available.

**To be eligible for testing**, completed applications, birth certificates and all required documents must be **received at the DeKalb County Sheriff's Office no later than March 31<sup>st</sup>, at 4:00 p.m.**
